Summary The position is responsible for coordinating with the Seasonal Gun Club Operator all logistical needs associated with day to day operations as well as pre-planned special events while providing for retail sales in the clubhouse.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Ensure the park is opened and closed according to established schedule

Maintain available posted calendar for public regarding upcoming events

Sell retail inventory (to include but not limited to ammunitions, hats, concession items, etc.)

Stock and count inventory regularly (Responsible for inventory of supplies required to perform daily operating tasks)

Maintains a sufficient supply of materials and equipment necessary to perform the tasks assigned

Maintains inventory log and records all supplies and materials requisitioned and consumed

Maintains facility grounds, including, but not limited to trash and litter removal, including spent shotgun hulls, restroom cleaning, weed eating, herbicide application, and trimming

Maintains service logs and records of all maintenance and repair work performed

Regularly maintain targets in all machines throughout park; including skeet, trap and sporting clay machines

Run end of day POS reports and submit to parks department, while delivering a nightly deposit to the assigned financial institution.
